Bitcoin Diaries: 6/12/26

As a reminder, the bitcoin Accumulation Program is a process attempting to assess and communicate the attractiveness of bitcoin's price. Basically, we are trying to determine good times to buy or add positions in bitcoin and to help understand what is happening with the price of bitcoin on a weekly basis.

The goal of this approach is to help make investors feel more comfortable with a long-term perspective when approaching a very volatile asset by providing a logic-based accumulation approach. WHAT THE INDICATORS ARE TELLING US THIS WEEK

- RSI: RSI (top study, blue line) is very oversold
- Trend: The Trend Score (middle study, yellow) is negative
- Cycle: Cycle Score is signaling a potential bottoming in process (bottom study, green line)
- Distribution Range: bitcoin has fallen below the short-term trading range.
- Fibonacci retracement: bitcoin has not only fallen below the 0.618 retracement but has set a marginal new low.

Conclusion: On May 7 we lowered bitcoin’s score from 6 to 5 because of the potential for a short-term top indicated by our cycle indicator. Since then, bitcoin has fallen below key retracement levels and has set a new low. Another consideration is that bitcoin could be back in a longer term downtrend from the all-time high last October. That is the bad news. The bright spot is that bitcoin appears oversold with RSI having fallen into the 20’s and the Cycle Score signaling that a bottoming process could be in place. We are lowering the score to 4, indicating neutral, with the cycle offsetting the lower trend.
